SHOWER HOSE FITTING GUIDE

Please note the shower hose comes with the water saving (12l/min) regulator attached. Regulators are NOT suitable for use with electric or pumped showers, so if you have either an electric or pumped shower, simply take it off by unscrewing.

PREPARATION:

Remove all parts from their packaging and inspect for any transport damage prior to fitting. Make sure your taps are turned off before you begin fitting. These fitting guidelines have been prepared to help you but you must exercise due care and attention at all times. We do not accept any responsibility for damage / problems that may occur through improper fitting or use.

CLEANING:

We recommend you clean your shower hose and regulator from time to time with a damp cloth to remove any scum / lime scale build up. N.B: using abrasive chemicals may cause damage, and as such we do not recommend these are used.

TECHNICAL DATA:

The pre-fitted water saving regulator operates at a water flow rate of 12 litres per minute, however please note that there may be differences in flow rates.

WARRANTY: The shower hose is covered under warranty for 2 years against any manufacturing defects. In the unlikely event that your contents break and/or are faulty within the 2 year warranty period through no fault of your own, please contact us directly.

FITTING TO A SHOWER UNIT OR BATH/SHOWER MIXER:

STEP 1

Simply unscrew your existing hose from your shower or bath shower fitting:



STEP 2

Screw the end of the hose (the end with the regulator on) to your shower or bath/shower mixer fitting, until tight.

Attach your existing shower head onto the remaining end of the hose.
